1 On page 1, line 23, after "chokehold" strike "or neck restraint"

2 On page 1, line 26, after "section" insert "and the determination 3 made by the criminal justice training commission under subsection (4) 4 of this section"

5 On page 2, beginning on line 1, after "(b)" strike all material 6 through "flow" on line 3 and insert ""Lateral vascular neck 7 restraint" means the use of a control technique where pressure is 8 applied to the sides of the neck, using a combination of 9 physiological factors to restrict blood flow to the brain, which may 10 cause the subject to temporarily lose consciousness"

11 On page 2, after line 3, insert the following:

"(4) The criminal justice training commission shall conduct a 12 study to determine whether the use of a lateral vascular neck 13 restraint constitutes deadly force, as defined in RCW 9A.16.010. The 14 criminal justice training commission shall publish its findings in a 15 16 report on its website by December 1, 2021. If the commission 17 determines the use of a lateral vascular neck restraint does not constitute deadly force, the report required under this subsection 18 must include a determination as to the appropriate circumstances for 19 20 use of a lateral vascular neck restraint by a peace officer."

EFFECT: Removes the prohibition against the use of neck restraints; modifies the definition of neck restraints; requires the CJTC to conduct a study on the use of lateral vascular neck restraints, publish its findings, and include a determination as to whether a lateral vascular neck restraint constitutes deadly force; requires law enforcement policies to be consistent with the determination by the CJTC.
