1 AN ACT Relating to hunters under the age of fourteen; and amending  
2 RCW 77.32.010 and 77.15.160.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 77.32.010 and 2008 c 329 s 923 are each amended to  
5 read as follows:

6 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, a recreational  
7 license issued by the director is required to hunt for or take wild  
8 animals or wild birds, fish for, take, or harvest fish, shellfish, and  
9 seaweed. A recreational fishing or shellfish license is not required  
10 for carp, smelt, and crawfish, and a hunting license is not required  
11 for bullfrogs.

12 (2) A permit issued by the department is required to park a motor  
13 vehicle upon improved department access facilities.

14 (3) All hunters under the age of fourteen are required to be  
15 accompanied by a person age eighteen or older who has satisfied the  
16 requirement to complete a training course as provided in RCW 77.32.155,  
17 or who is not required by the terms of RCW 77.32.155 to complete a  
18 training course, when hunting on land owned by a public entity for wild

1 animals or wild birds. The accompanying adult hunter must stay within  
2 a physical range that permits continual unaided visual and auditory  
3 communication with the accompanied hunter.

4 (4) During the 2007-09 fiscal biennium to enable the implementation  
5 of the pilot project established in section 307, chapter 329, Laws of  
6 2008, a fishing permit issued to a nontribal member by the Colville  
7 Tribes shall satisfy the license requirements in subsection (1) of this  
8 section on the waters of Lake Rufus Woods and on the north shore of  
9 Lake Rufus Woods, and a Colville Tribes tribal member identification  
10 card shall satisfy the license requirements in subsection (1) of this  
11 section on all waters of Lake Rufus Woods.

12 **Sec. 2.** RCW 77.15.160 and 2000 c 107 s 237 are each amended to  
13 read as follows:

14 A person is guilty of ((an)) a natural resources infraction, which  
15 shall be cited and punished as provided under chapter 7.84 RCW, if the  
16 person:

17 (1) Fails to immediately record a catch of fish or shellfish on a  
18 catch record card required by RCW 77.32.430, or required by rule of the  
19 commission under this title; ((or))

20 (2) Fishes for personal use using barbed hooks in violation of any  
21 rule; ((or))

22 (3) Engages in unaccompanied hunting in violation of the minimum  
23 age requirements established in RCW 77.32.010; or

24 (4) Violates any other rule of the commission or director that is  
25 designated by rule as an infraction.
