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- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 71A.10.100 and 2022 c 247 s 1 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 $((\frac{1}{1}))$ The department shall hire two permanent, full-time employees to regularly review and maintain the no-paid services 8 caseload. This includes, but is not limited to, updating the no-paid 9 10 services caseload to accurately reflect a current head count of 11 eligible individuals and identifying the number of individuals 12 contacted who are currently interested in receiving a paid service 13 from the developmental disabilities administration and individual would like services now or within the next year. Beginning 14 15 December 1, 2022, the department shall annually report this 16 information to the governor and the appropriate committees of the 17 legislature.
 - (((2) A client on the no-paid services caseload shall receive case resource management services. The case resource manager's duties include: (a) Contacting and responding to the client to discuss the client's service needs, and (b) explaining to the client the service
