1 AN ACT Relating to the collection of health care professionals' 2 information at the time of license application and license renewal; 3 and adding a new section to chapter 18.130 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 18.130 6 RCW to read as follows:

7 (1) All applicants who submit applications for licensure on or 8 after January 1, 2025, shall provide the following information with 9 their application:

- 10 (a) Race;
- 11 (b) Ethnicity;
- 12 (c) Gender;
- 13 (d) Languages spoken;

14 (e) Provider specialty, where applicable;

15 (f) Primary practice location, if known at the time of 16 application; and

17 (g) Secondary practice location, if applicable and if known at 18 the time of application.

(2) All license holders shall provide the following informationwhen they renew their licenses on or after January 1, 2025, in

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1 addition to any other information required by the relevant 2 disciplining authority:

3 (a) The information in subsection (1)(a) through (e) of this 4 section, except, after license holders provide this information one 5 time, they shall be required to provide only changes to this 6 information with subsequent renewals;

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(b) Whether the licensee is currently practicing;

(c) Primary practice location at the time of renewal; and

9 (d) Secondary practice location at the time of renewal, if 10 applicable.

(3) The form used to collect information under this section must include the same race and ethnicity categories and subgroups required for the collection of student-level data in RCW 28A.300.042 (1) and (3).

15 (4) The department shall not sell the information collected 16 pursuant to subsection (1) or (2) of this section to any third party.

(5) Applicants and licensees subject to demographic and practice information provision requirements under chapters 18.71, 18.71A, and 18.71B RCW are exempt from the requirements of this section.

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
