1 AN ACT Relating to the appointment of counsel for crime victims; 2 and adding a new section to chapter 7.69 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 7.69 RCW 5 to read as follows:

6 The court shall provide counsel to a victim of any felony offense 7 at public expense when either: (1) The victim is unable to afford 8 counsel, or the expense of counsel would result in a substantial 9 hardship to the victim, or (2) the victim does not have practical access to funds with which to pay counsel. Counsel shall assist the 10 victim in exercising the constitutional and statutory rights afforded 11 to victims found in Article I, section 35 of the state Constitution 12 13 and state law.
