**SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 2280**

1            AN ACT Relating to scratch tickets as a promotional activity; and  
2 adding a new section to chapter 67.70 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 67.70 RCW  
5 to read as follows:

6            (1) The state lottery may provide as a promotional activity, free  
7 or for a charge, scratch tickets to persons otherwise eligible to  
8 purchase lottery tickets, and to licensed retailers for distribution to  
9 persons otherwise eligible to purchase lottery tickets. Only scratch  
10 tickets with a retail price of one or two dollars may be used under  
11 this section. The state lottery shall limit promotional scratch  
12 tickets to no more than one percent of the annual sales of one or two  
13 dollar scratch tickets. Promotional scratch tickets provided under  
14 this section must be conducted in accordance with rules established for  
15 promotional activities. Rules adopted under this section must include  
16 audit and reporting provisions.

17            (2) The lottery commission must review the use of promotional  
18 scratch tickets annually and report its findings to the appropriate

1 committees of the legislature. Subject to its annual review, the  
2 lottery commission must set quantity guidelines and may suspend the use  
3 of promotional scratch tickets on a fiscal year basis.
