- 8 WHEREAS, The commercial fishing industry directly and indirectly 9 employs thousands of people and is one of the largest industries in 10 Washington state; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The annual commercial fishing harvest is vital to the 12 growth and stability of the Washington state economy; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The life of a fisher is fraught with danger and hardship 14 most people will never face, and courage is required for anyone who 15 chooses to work on the sea, as fishers must brave the elements in 16 order to harvest the ocean's resources; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The men and women who work on fishing boats, often in 18 dangerous circumstances, deserve our admiration, thanks, and, when 19 tragedy strikes, our remembrance; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Too often, the brave men and women of our fishing fleet 21 lose their lives, a tragedy that not only impacts the close-knit 22 community of fishing families in our region, but also our entire 23 state;
