- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.92.025 and 2006 c 340 s 4 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 (1) In addition to the objectives stated in RCW 43.92.020, the geological survey must conduct and maintain an assessment of seismic,
- 8 landslide, and tsunami hazards in Washington. This assessment must
- 9 ((include the identification and mapping of))apply the best
- 10 practicable technology, including light detection and ranging (lidar)
- 11 mapping, to identify and map volcanic, seismic, landslide, and
- 12 tsunami hazards, ((an estimation of))and estimate potential hazard
- 13 consequences((τ)) and the likelihood of $((\frac{\text{occurrence}}{\sigma}))$ a hazard
- 14 <u>occurring</u>.

- 11 There is created in the state treasury the surveys and maps account which shall be a separate account consisting of funds 12 received or collected under chapters 43.92, 58.22, and 58.24 RCW, 13 moneys appropriated to it by law. This account shall be used 14 15 exclusively by the department of natural resources for carrying out 16 the purposes and provisions of chapters 43.92, 58.22, and 58.24 RCW. Appropriations from the account shall be expended for no other 17 18 purposes.
