1            AN ACT Relating to driver's license formats for persons  
2 approaching twenty-one years of age; and amending RCW 46.20.105.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.20.105 and 2000 c 115 s 5 are each amended to  
5 read as follows:

6            (1)(a) The department may provide a method to distinguish the  
7 driver's license of a person who is under the age of twenty-one from  
8 the driver's license of a person who is twenty-one years of age or  
9 older.

10           (b) The department must allow for a person who applies to renew  
11 his or her driver's license within one week of his or her twenty-  
12 first birthday to convert the driver's license to the format of a  
13 driver's license for a person who is twenty-one years of age or  
14 older.

15           (2) An instruction permit must be identified as an "instruction  
16 permit" and issued in a distinctive form as determined by the  
17 department.

1           (3)   An intermediate license must be identified as an  
2 "intermediate license" and issued in a distinctive form as determined  
3 by the department.
