- AN ACT Relating to creating a silver alert system; amending RCW
- 2 13.60.010; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

Sec. 1. The legislature finds that Washington 4 NEW SECTION. state's elderly population is growing and the number of individuals 5 6 with dementia is increasing. The legislature further finds that approximately sixty percent of individuals with dementia will wander 7 at least once and that if not found within twenty-four hours, up to 8 half of wandering seniors with dementia will suffer serious injury or 9 10 death. The legislature further finds that the state of Washington has 11 a compelling interest in protecting the safety of vulnerable citizens 12 with cognitive impairments. The legislature further finds that while the Washington state patrol does maintain an "endangered missing 13 person advisory plan" which creates a public notification system to 14 locate missing persons with developmental disabilities and vulnerable 15 adults, the public may not fully understand that this program is 16 locate adults 17 primarily designed to with special needs. 18 legislature further finds that renaming this important public 19 notification system will help the public to understand they are 20 looking for a person with a developmental disability or a vulnerable 21 adult. This will help to locate missing persons with Alzheimer's

- disease, dementia, or other mental disabilities aid in their safe return, and will help prevent unnecessary suffering and death.
- 3 Sec. 2. RCW 13.60.010 and 2013 c 285 s 1 are each amended to 4 read as follows:
- 5 The Washington state patrol shall establish a missing children and endangered person clearinghouse which shall include the б maintenance and operation of a toll-free telephone hotline. The 7 clearinghouse shall distribute information to local law enforcement 8 agencies, school districts, the department of social and health 9 services, and the general public regarding missing children and 10 11 endangered persons. The information shall include pictures, bulletins, training sessions, reports, and biographical materials 12 that will assist in local law enforcement efforts to locate missing 13 children and endangered persons. The state patrol shall also maintain 14 15 a regularly updated computerized link with national and other 16 statewide missing person systems or clearinghouses, and within 17 existing resources, shall develop and implement a plan, commonly 18 known as an "amber alert plan" or ((an "endangered missing person advisory)) a "silver alert plan," for voluntary cooperation between 19 20 local, state, tribal, and other law enforcement agencies, state government agencies, radio and television stations, cable and 21 satellite systems, and social media pages and sites to enhance the 22 public's ability to assist in recovering abducted children and 23 24 missing endangered persons consistent with the state endangered 25 missing person advisory plan.

- 27 (a) "Child" or "children" means an individual under eighteen 28 years of age.
 - (b) "Missing endangered person" means a person ((with a developmental disability as defined in RCW 71A.10.020(4) or a vulnerable adult as defined in RCW 74.34.020(17),)) believed to be in danger because of age, health, mental or physical disability, in combination with environmental or weather conditions, or is believed to be unable to return to safety without assistance and who is:
- 35 <u>(i) A person with a developmental disability as defined in RCW</u> 36 71A.10.020(5);
- 37 (ii) A vulnerable adult as defined in RCW 74.34.020(17); or
- 38 <u>(iii) A person who has been diagnosed as having Alzheimer's</u> 39 disease, dementia, or other mental disability.
