- 1 AN ACT Relating to transferring dedicated accounts for certain 2 professional licenses to the business and professions account; 3 amending RCW 43.24.150; creating a new section; repealing 18.08.240, 18.39.810, 18.96.210, 18.140.260, 18.220.120, 4 and
- 5 18.310.160; and providing an effective date.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 6
- 7 Sec. 1. RCW 43.24.150 and 2017 c 281 s 40 are each amended to read as follows: 8
- (1) The business and professions account is created in the state 9 10 treasury. All receipts from business or professional licenses, 11 registrations, certifications, renewals, examinations, or 12 penalties assessed and collected by the department from the following chapters must be deposited into the account:

- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. Any residual balance of funds remaining, as of December 31, 2025, in the architects' license account except as 11 provided in RCW 18.08.510, the funeral and cemetery account, the 12 13 landscape architects' license account, the real estate appraiser commission account, the geologists' account, and the appraisal 14 15 management company account must be transferred to the business and 16 professions account in RCW 43.24.150. The treasurer shall make the 17 transfer after being notified by the office of financial management that it has completed the financial statement for fiscal year 2025, 18 19 and no later than February 28, 2026.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. This act takes effect January 1, 2026.
