AN ACT Relating to creating Mount St. Helens special license plates; reenacting and amending RCW 46.18.200, 46.17.220, and 46.68.420; adding a new section to chapter 46.04 RCW; and providing an effective date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 Sec. 1. RCW 46.18.200 and 2022 c 239 s 2 and 2022 c 117 s 2 are 7 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

8 (1) Special license plate series reviewed and approved by the 9 department:

10 (a) May be issued in lieu of standard issue or personalized 11 license plates for vehicles required to display one and two license 12 plates unless otherwise specified;

13 (b) Must be issued under terms and conditions established by the 14 department;

15 (c) Must not be issued for vehicles registered under chapter 16 46.87 RCW; and

17 (d) Must display a symbol or artwork approved by the department.

(2) The department approves and shall issue the following speciallicense plates, subject to subsection (5) of this section:

If the 24 volunteer firefighter stays in service for at least ((ten)) 10 years 25 and then leaves, the license plate may be retained by the former 26 volunteer firefighter and as long as the license plate is retained 27 for use the person will continue to pay the future registration 28 renewals. A qualifying volunteer firefighter may have no more than 29 one set of license plates per vehicle, and a maximum of two sets per 30 applicant, for their personal vehicles. If the volunteer firefighter 31 is convicted of a violation of RCW 46.61.502 or a felony, the license plates must be surrendered upon conviction. 32

(5) The department shall not issue the Seattle NHL hockey special license plate until the department receives signature sheets satisfying the requirements identified in RCW 46.18.110(2)(f).
