- 1 AN ACT Relating to restricting certain methods of selling
- 2 marijuana; adding new sections to chapter 69.50 RCW; and prescribing

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The state liquor control board may not
- 6 issue, transfer, or renew a marijuana retail license for any business
- 7 that operates or intends to operate a drive through purchase facility
- 8 where marijuana, marijuana concentrates, marijuana-infused products,
- 9 or useable marijuana are to be sold at retail and dispensed through a
- 10 window or door to a purchaser in or on a motor vehicle.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The state liquor control board may not
- 12 issue, transfer, or renew a marijuana retail license for any business
- 13 that operates or intends to operate a vending machine, as defined in
- 14 RCW 82.08.080(3), for the sale of marijuana, marijuana concentrates,
- 15 marijuana-infused products, or useable marijuana at retail.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** It is unlawful to sell marijuana,
- 17 marijuana concentrates, marijuana-infused products, or useable
- 18 marijuana through a drive through purchase facility that dispenses

- 1 through a window or door to a purchaser in or on a motor vehicle. A
- 2 violation of this section is a misdemeanor.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** It is unlawful to sell marijuana,
- 4 marijuana concentrates, marijuana-infused products, or useable
- 5 marijuana in a vending machine, as defined in RCW 82.08.080(3). A
- 6 violation of this section is a misdemeanor.
- 7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** Sections 1 through 4 of this act are each
- 8 added to chapter 69.50 RCW.
