- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.32.060 and 2011 c 336 s 357 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
 - (1) A person is guilty of manslaughter in the first degree when:
- 8 (a) He or she recklessly causes the death of another person; $9 ((\frac{Or}{O}))$
- 10 (b) He or she intentionally and unlawfully kills an unborn quick 11 child by inflicting any injury upon the mother of such child; or
- (c) He or she intentionally and unlawfully delivers a controlled substance in that is a Schedule I or II controlled substance in violation of RCW 69.50.401(2) (a), (b), or (c) and the controlled
- 15 <u>substance</u> is <u>subsequently</u> used by the person to whom it was
- 16 <u>delivered</u>, resulting in the death of the user.
- 17 (2) Manslaughter in the first degree is a class A felony.
