1       AN ACT Relating to digital copies of public employees' collective  
2 bargaining agreements; adding a new section to chapter 41.56 RCW;  
3 adding a new section to chapter 41.80 RCW; adding a new section to  
4 chapter 41.76 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 41.59 RCW; adding a  
5 new section to chapter 49.39 RCW; adding a new section to chapter  
6 28B.52 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 47.64 RCW; adding a new  
7 section to chapter 49.66 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 41.58  
8 RCW.

9       BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

10       NEW SECTION.   **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 41.56 RCW  
11 to read as follows:

12       The employer shall submit a digital copy of their collective  
13 bargaining agreement to the commission within thirty days of the  
14 effective date of the collective bargaining agreement.

15       NEW SECTION.   **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 41.80 RCW  
16 to read as follows:

17       The employer shall submit a digital copy of their collective

1 bargaining agreement to the commission within thirty days of the  
2 effective date of the collective bargaining agreement.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 41.76 RCW  
4 to read as follows:

5 The employer shall submit a digital copy of their collective  
6 bargaining agreement to the commission within thirty days of the  
7 effective date of the collective bargaining agreement.

8 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 41.59 RCW  
9 to read as follows:

10 The employer shall submit a digital copy of their collective  
11 bargaining agreement to the commission within thirty days of the  
12 effective date of the collective bargaining agreement.

13 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** A new section is added to chapter 49.39 RCW  
14 to read as follows:

15 The employer shall submit a digital copy of their collective  
16 bargaining agreement to the commission within thirty days of the  
17 effective date of the collective bargaining agreement.

18 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 6.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.52 RCW  
19 to read as follows:

20 Employers of academic employees under this chapter shall submit a  
21 digital copy of their collective bargaining agreement to the commission  
22 within thirty days of the effective date of the collective bargaining  
23 agreement.

24 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7.** A new section is added to chapter 47.64 RCW  
25 to read as follows:

26 The employer shall submit a digital copy of their collective  
27 bargaining agreement to the commission within thirty days of the  
28 effective date of the collective bargaining agreement.

29 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 8.** A new section is added to chapter 49.66 RCW  
30 to read as follows:

31 The employer shall submit a digital copy of their collective  
32 bargaining agreement to the department within thirty days of the

1 effective date of the collective bargaining agreement. The department  
2 shall maintain a web site that allows the public to view and download  
3 the collective bargaining agreements submitted by employers pursuant to  
4 this section. The collective bargaining agreements shall be available  
5 in a uniform digital format. Expired collective bargaining agreements  
6 shall be available on the web site for up to ten years following  
7 expiration.

8 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 9.** A new section is added to chapter 41.58 RCW  
9 to read as follows:

10 The commission shall maintain a web site that allows the public to  
11 view and download the collective bargaining agreements submitted by  
12 employers pursuant to sections 1 through 8 of this act. The collective  
13 bargaining agreements shall be available in a uniform digital format.  
14 Expired collective bargaining agreements shall be available on the web  
15 site for up to ten years following expiration.
