Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires Wisconsin Economic Development corporation to make grants to small or medium sized manufacturers in Wisconsin for the purchase of advanced manufacturing technology hardware and software. "Small- or medium-sized manufacturer" means a manufacturer headquartered in Wisconsin who had \$50 million or less in gross revenues in the manufacturer's fiscal year immediately preceding the date of the manufacturer's application for a grant under this section. No grant awarded under this section may exceed 33 percent of the purchase price paid by the manufacturer for the hardware and software or \$200,000, whichever is less. The corporation may not award a grant under this section unless the small or medium-sized manufacturer has established an advanced technology adoption implementation plan approved by the Wisconsin Center for Manufacturing and Productivity, Inc.

No additional funding for staffing or administration is made available through this proposal. Thus, adding these requirements to the corporation will reduce resources available for other activities and programs
