## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill creates provisions intended to limit access by a pupil or minor to harmful material in public libraries and to harmful or offensive material in public schools.

Local Impact: Indeterminate

This bill does not include additional funding for public schools, charter schools, or public libraries, even though the bill would impose an administrative burden on the affected institutions. Compliance with the bill's provisions would require additional personnel hours to be diverted to installation of software, managing software, material review, and providing materials as requested, the costs of which would have to be absorbed by existing staff resources, unless the library or school were able to bring in additional staff to conduct this work.

## Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Long-range fiscal implications are indeterminate.
