## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This proposal would allow minors aged 16 and older to be vaccinated without the consent of their parent or guardian. If a minor is unwilling to consent to a third partner payer being billed, then the minor will be responsible for fees associated with vaccination. In that circumstance, the Department would purchase vaccine doses, and then bill the minor based on that minor's ability to pay. The Department estimates that administrative costs of this proposal, along with minor cost sharing, can be absorbed by existing DHS resources.
