1 AN ACT relating to: location of deaths from COVID-19.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Health Services to collect and report to the legislature the living situation location of all deaths from COVID-19 by June 30, 2022.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 2 SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.
- 3 (1) Reporting location of COVID-19 deaths.
- 4 (a) In this subsection, "COVID-19" means the infection caused by the
- 5 SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, including any viral variant derived from SARS-CoV-2
- 6 coronavirus.
- 7 (b) By June 30, 2022, the department of health services shall collect the living
- 8 situation location of all deaths from COVID-19 and shall report to the legislature
