2023 ASSEMBLY BILL 131

March 28, 2023 - Introduced by Representatives SCHUTT, ARMSTRONG, C. 1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 92.06 (1) (b) 2. of the statutes; **relating to:** membership in
2 county land conservation committees.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, each county board must create a land conservation committee and must appoint to the committee a person from the county's U.S. Department of Agriculture Farm Service Agency (FSA). This bill removes the requirement to appoint an FSA member to a county land conservation committee and replaces it with a requirement to appoint a person who is engaged in an agricultural use. "Agricultural use" is defined as crop or forage production; keeping livestock; beekeeping; nursery, sod, or Christmas tree production; floriculture; aquaculture; fur farming; and forest management.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 92.06 (1) (b) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:
