1 **AN ACT** *to create* 6.31 of the statutes; **relating to:** voter registration forms and
2 information provided to certain high school students.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires each school board in Wisconsin to provide to each high school student in the school board's school district who becomes eligible to register to vote:

1. A voter registration form and information concerning eligibility to vote.
2. Nonpartisan materials describing the role of the citizen and the importance of voting in elections.
