## 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 628

February 24, 2012 – Introduced by Representatives BIES and STEINEKE. Referred to Committee on Education.

1     **AN ACT** *to create* 118.46 (3) of the statutes; **relating to:** providing a penalty for  
2           failure to report bullying in public schools.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Current law requires each school board to develop a policy prohibiting bullying by pupils. A school board may adopt the model school policy on bullying developed by the Department of Public Instruction.

This bill provides that if a school district's policy requires that school district officials and employees report incidents of bullying, and a school district official or employee fails to report an incident of bullying within the period required, the official or employee is subject to a forfeiture of \$200 for each violation.
