April 22, 2010 – Introduced by Representatives ROTH, SPANBAUER and TOWNSEND, cosponsored by Senator ELLIS, by request of Stanley Reed. Referred to Joint Survey Committee on Tax Exemptions.

1 **AN ACT to create** 77.54 (58) of the statutes; **relating to:** a sales and use tax
2 exemption for medical physics performance testing of medical imaging and
3 therapeutic equipment.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides a sales and use tax exemption for medical physics performance testing of medical imaging and therapeutic equipment.

Because this bill relates to an exemption from state or local taxes, it may be referred to the Joint Survey Committee on Tax Exemptions for a report to be printed as an appendix to the bill.
