7	Whereas, homeownership is a part of the American Dream and it is a priority
8	of this body to make continued efforts to ensure homeownership is more attainable
9	for residents and families all across Wisconsin; and
10	Whereas, cutting government red tape and regulation and reducing taxes are
11	integral to making homeownership a reality; and
12	Whereas, continued efforts over the last eight years to keep property taxes in
13	check has helped to make homeownership possible for thousands of Wisconsinites,
14	and has helped families and the elderly to stay in the homes they love; and
