- 2 Whereas, over 160,000 American, British, and Canadian troops landed across
- 3 50 miles of Normandy beaches in the early hours of June 6, 1944; and
- 4 Whereas, Wisconsinites joined their fellow Americans and Allied troops to
- 5 brave bullets and shellfire as they waded ashore through freezing water or
- 6 parachuted from planes to land behind enemy lines; and
- 7 Whereas, D-Day, codenamed “Operation Neptune,” constituted the largest
- 8 amphibious attack in history, and became a major turning point of World War II in
- 9 Europe; and
- 10 Whereas, the “Great Crusade,” as General Dwight D. Eisenhower called it,
- 11 claimed the lives of 10,000 Allied men on June 6 alone, including over 6,000
- 12 Americans; and
