1     **Relating to:** declaring the second Friday of July as Collector Vehicle Appreciation  
2             Day in Wisconsin.

3             Whereas, many people in Wisconsin and the nation maintain classic vehicles  
4     as a pastime and do so with great passion and as a means of individual expression;

6             Whereas, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation issued more than 5,000  
7     collector license plates in 2013; and

8             Whereas, classic and collector vehicle clubs have been established throughout  
9     the state in both small towns and large cities; and

10            Whereas, classic and collector vehicle gatherings and “cruises” are held as a  
11     means to improve the business climate in local communities; and

12            Whereas, the state legislature recognizes the effect that the more than  
13     100-year history of automobiles, motorcycles, and other vehicles has had on the  
14     economic progress of Wisconsin and the United States and supports wholeheartedly  
15     all activities involved in the restoration and exhibition of classic vehicles; and
