



2011 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 79

December 2, 2011 - Introduced by Representatives E. COGGS, YOUNG, SINICKI, POCAN, BERCEAU, ROYS, C. TAYLOR and STASKUNAS, cosponsored by Senators S. COGGS and TAYLOR. Referred to Committee on Assembly Organization.

1 **Relating to:** expression of support by members of the Wisconsin assembly for the
2 American Jobs Act.

3 Whereas, the American Jobs Act requires immediate passage to strengthen the
4 economy and protect Wisconsin's middle class; and

5 Whereas, the plan would go into effect immediately and would create jobs; and

6 Whereas, President Obama's bill will cut the payroll tax in half to 3.1 percent
7 for about 98 percent of businesses in the country; and

8 Whereas, in Wisconsin, some 110,000 businesses would receive a payroll tax
9 reduction under the American Jobs Act; and

10 Whereas, a typical Wisconsin household with a median income of about \$51,000
11 would receive a tax cut of about \$1,580; and

12 Whereas, the president's plan includes \$50 billion in immediate investments
13 for our crumbling highways, transit rail, and aviation infrastructure, helping make
14 the United States competitive in the 21st century economy; and
