3           Whereas, on September 24, 2021, the world's greatest golfers converged at  
4       Whistling Straits, outside Sheboygan, Wisconsin, to compete in the 2020 Ryder Cup;

6           Whereas, Herb Kohler commissioned the construction of Whistling Straits on  
7       an abandoned airfield named Camp Haven; and

8           Whereas, over 40,000 fans flocked to the course each day to support Team USA  
9       in the biennial competition that was postponed one year due to the COVID-19  
10      pandemic; and

11          Whereas, the Ryder Cup generated an estimated \$135 million in economic  
12      impact to the region and highlighted the world-class hospitality industry in the  
13      Sheboygan area; and
