



2023 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 89

November 7, 2023 - Introduced by Representatives S. JOHNSON, DITTRICH, HURD, SCHMIDT, O'CONNOR, BALDEH, ORTIZ-VELEZ, MELOTIK, BEHNKE, GUNDRUM, WICHGERS, TITTL and BRANDTJEN, cosponsored by Senator JACQUE. Referred to Committee on Rules.

AUTHORS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

1 **Relating to:** mourning the loss of all Americans murdered by Hamas in its attack
2 against Israel and calling for the swift and safe release of Americans held
3 hostage and the return of Americans murdered.

4 Whereas, the United States government has confirmed 30 Americans killed, 13
5 unaccounted for, and numerous others held hostage as a result of Hamas's barbaric
6 attack against Israel on October 7, 2023; and

7 Whereas, a terrorist attack against Americans of this magnitude has not
8 occurred since September 11, 2001; and

9 Whereas, while the citizens of Wisconsin acknowledge the horrific attacks
10 against Jewish people and the State of Israel, we also recognize that this atrocity
11 targets the American people; and

12 Whereas, the Wisconsin State Legislature, as a collective body, condemns all
13 forms of anti-Semitic rhetoric on Wisconsin's college or university campuses; now,
14 therefore, be it

1 **Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That** the Wisconsin
2 State Legislature implores President Biden and the United States government to
3 bring home all Americans murdered or held in captivity by Hamas; and

4 **Be it further resolved, That** the Wisconsin State Legislature stands behind
5 President Biden and the United States government in their efforts to support Israel's
6 defense forces in the battle to eradicate Hamas from the globe.
