| 10 | departments in Wisconsin Rapids, Grand Rapids, Nekoosa, Rudolph, Pittsville,        |
| 11 | Plainfield, and Westfield, with eight firefighters requiring medical attention; and |
| 12 | Whereas, soon after the fire began, local officials requested assistance from the   |
| 13 | staff at the Wisconsin Operating Engineers Local 139 Coloma Training Center; and    |

Whereas, the Operating Engineers responded immediately with staff and equipment to fight the fire, and with great efficiency and considerable courage they sent 14 staff to operate six bulldozers and two water trucks; and
