1	Relating to: condemning the violence at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School
2	in Parkland, Florida.
3	Whereas, on Wednesday, February 14, 2018, in Parkland, Florida, a gunman
4	opened fire on innocent students, teachers, and staff at Marjory Stoneman Douglas
5	High School; and
6	Whereas, the Wisconsin State Assembly remembers and honors the families of
7	those who were harmed or needlessly lost their lives that day; and
8	Whereas, the State Assembly especially recognizes the heroic actions of
9	members of the school community, including teacher Melissa Falkowski who helped
10	hide 19 students, a yet unnamed janitor who diverted students away from the
11	shooter, and football coach Aaron Feis who lost his life shielding students from
12	gunfire; and
13	Whereas, the State Assembly strongly denounces those who use senseless

14 violence to inflict harm onto fellow citizens; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the assembly, That the members of the Wisconsin State 1 $\mathbf{2}$ Assembly condemn the violence that occurred in Parkland, Florida and extend our 3 condolences to the families of those who were harmed or needlessly lost their lives. 4
