



## 2009 SENATE BILL 228

June 4, 2009 - Introduced by JOINT LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL. Referred to Committee on Small Business, Emergency Preparedness, Technical Colleges, and Consumer Protection.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** disaster assistance and making an appropriation.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

JOINT LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL PREFATORY NOTE: This bill was prepared for the Joint Legislative Council's Special Committee on Emergency Management and Continuity of Government. The bill provides \$1 million in general purpose revenue (GPR) in each fiscal year of the 2009-11 biennium for the state disaster assistance program. The program provides payments to local governments for a portion of damages and costs incurred in a major catastrophe if federal disaster assistance is not available.

2 **SECTION 1. Fiscal changes.**

3 (1) DISASTER ASSISTANCE. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes  
4 for the appropriation to the department of military affairs under section 20.465 (3)  
5 (b) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2009, the dollar amount is increased by

1 \$1,000,000 for the first fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this subsection  
2 takes effect for the purpose for which the appropriation is made. In the schedule  
3 under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of  
4 military affairs under section 20.465 (3) (b) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of  
5 2009, the dollar amount is increased by \$1,000,000 for the second fiscal year of the  
6 fiscal biennium in which this subsection takes effect for the purpose for which the  
7 appropriation is made.

8 **SECTION 2. Effective date.**

9 (1) This act takes effect on the day after publication, or on the 2nd day after  
10 publication of the 2009–11 biennial budget act, whichever is later.
