



2009 SENATE BILL 95

March 3, 2009 – Introduced by Senators LEIBHAM and A. LASEE, cosponsored by Representatives A. OTT, TOWNSEND and SPANBAUER. Referred to Committee on Judiciary, Corrections, Insurance, Campaign Finance Reform, and Housing.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 753.06 (4) (a) of the statutes; **relating to:** adding a circuit court
2 branch in Calumet County.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

As of August 1, 2010, this bill adds one circuit court branch in Calumet County. For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 753.06 (4) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 753.06 (4) (a) Calumet County. The circuit has one branch. Commencing
5 August 1, 2010, the circuit has 2 branches.

6 **SECTION 2. Nonstatutory provisions.**

7 (1) The initial election for circuit judge for branch 2 of the circuit court for
8 Calumet County shall be at the spring election of 2010 for terms commencing August
9 1, 2010, and ending July 31, 2016.
