5 **21-13-309. Determination of amount to be included**
6 **in foundation program for each district.**

8 (m) In determining the amount to be included in
9 the foundation program for each district, the state
10 superintendent shall:

11 (v) Based upon ADM computations and
12 identified school configurations within each district
13 pursuant to paragraph (iv) of this subsection, compute
14 the foundation program amount for each district as
15 prescribed by the education resource block grant model
16 adopted by the Wyoming legislature as defined under W.S.
17 21-13-101(a)(xiv), as contained within the spreadsheets
18 and accompanying reports referenced under W.S. 21-13-
19 101(a)(xvii). The following criteria shall be used by
20 the state superintendent in the administration of the
21 education resource block grant model:

24 for health insurance shall be based upon:

2 annualized state contribution rate for employee only,
3 split contracts, employee plus spouse or children and
4 family coverage based on district weighted actual
5 participation in district health insurance plans shall
6 be multiplied by the lesser of the number of school
7 district employees funded within the education resource
8 block grant model that are actually enrolled in a school
9 district health insurance plan for the preceding school
10 year or the number of positions funded within the
11 education resource block grant model.
