Source of expenditure increase:

The source of the School Capital Construction Account (SCCA) expenditure increase comes from: 1) amending W.S. 21-15-109(c)(v) to provide the cost replacement values (CRV) to be based upon August 1 of the prior school year; and 2) the repeal of W.S. 21-15-109(c)(i)(C) to eliminate the seven-year phase-in of new gross square footage. The net increase of expenditures is estimated to be \$600,000 in FY 2019, \$400,000 in FY 2020, and \$400,000 in FY 2021.

The amendments to W.S. 21-15-109(c) (vi) and (vii) to increase the major maintenance formula multiplier to 2.5% will take effect in FY 2023, which will increase major maintenance expenditures from the SCCA. The estimated increases are \$21.4 million in FY 2023 and an additional \$1 million each year thereafter. This estimate may be higher or lower depending on the major maintenance formula variables (average daily membership, gross square footage and CRV).

Assumptions:

The above estimates were determined through the use of forecast major maintenance models utilized by LSO, based on the most recent available data for the 2017-18 school year.

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
