Catch Title: **Charter schools.**

Subject: Charter schools.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill revises the overall process for the approval and renewal of charter schools.
- The bill provides that, in addition to a local school district board, the State Loan and Investment Board can authorize charter schools.
- The bill makes revisions to the operations of charter schools including specifying the terms that must be included in a charter contract.
- The bill specifies how funding is determined for charter schools that are authorized by the State Loan and Investment Board.
- The bill limits the number of charter schools that can be approved by the State Loan and Investment Board to three until the Legislature takes further action.
- The bill requires the Joint Education Interim Committee to study charter schools during the 2021 interim.

Comments:

- Requires a report from the State Superintendent of Public Instruction to the Joint Education Interim Committee.
