Source of expenditure increase(decrease):

The appropriation in the bill would cover first-year funding for the proposed salary increases and the Supreme Court assumes these increases would become part of the standard budget request in future biennia.

## Assumptions:

The bill would increase judge salaries for each court level, cumulatively and for each judge, as follows:

Supreme Court = \$72,000 (5 judges)
District Court = \$\$324,000 (24 judges)
Circuit Court = \$619,000 (24 Judges)

For judges retired under the original judicial retirement plan, their retirement benefits are based on a percentage of current judicial salaries. Based on the proposed salaries, eighteen retired judges in this plan would receive a total of

approximately \$66,000 per year in increased benefit adjustments, with individual adjustments varying based on the judicial level in which they worked.
