Town officers-salary waiver.

## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to cities and towns; providing that elected
- 2 and appointed officers may elect not to receive a salary or
- 3 compensation while serving as elected or appointed
- 4 officers; providing legislative intent; and providing for
- 5 an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 9 **Section 1**. W.S. 15-2-103 and 15-3-205 by creating a
- 10 new subsection (c) are amended to read:

12 **15-2-103.** Officers; salaries.

- 14 The governing body shall fix the salaries for the mayor and
- 15 councilmen in towns not operating under the commission or

city manager form of government. The salaries shall be 1 2 fixed before their terms begin and shall not change during the term for which they are elected. The salary for mayor 3 4 shall be paid in twelve (12) or more installments and may 5 not exceed the maximum of twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000.00) per year. The salary for each councilman shall 6 be not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than one 7 8 hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) for actual attendance at 9 each regular or special meeting. All appointed officers 10 shall receive the salary or compensation as provided by law or ordinance. Any elected or appointed officers who are 11 entitled to receive a salary or compensation under this 12 13 section may elect, upon written notice submitted not less than two (2) weeks in advance of being paid, not to receive 14 all or the portion of the salary or compensation at any 15 16 time during their term.

(c) Any elected or appointed mayor or city councilman
may elect, upon written notice submitted to the city clerk
not less than two (2) weeks in advance of being paid, not

1	to receive all or part of their salary or compensation at
2	any time during their term.

4	Section 2. This act is intended to allow elected and
5	appointed officers to elect not to receive a salary or
6	compensation. Nothing in this act shall be construed to
7	affect the rights or authority of other elected or
8	appointed officials not specified in this act to elect not
9	to receive a salary or compensation.
10	
11	Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon
12	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
13	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
14	Constitution.
