Ignition interlock program fees.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to department of transportation funding;
2 setting standards for ignition interlock driver's license
3 fees; requiring a minimum fee; setting a maximum fee;
4 providing for the deposit and continuous appropriation of
5 fees; and providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-7-401 by creating new subsections
10 (d) and (e) is amended to read:

11

12 **31-7-401. Ignition interlock licenses; definitions;**
13 **administration and enforcement.**

15 (d) The department shall establish a fee chargeable
16 to every person applying for an ignition interlock

1 restricted license. The fee shall compensate the
2 department for all the costs directly associated with
3 operating the ignition interlock program required by this
4 article, but in no event shall the fee exceed one hundred
5 twenty-five dollars (\$125.00). The fee shall not be
6 collected from any indigent person who qualifies for the
7 benefits described by paragraph (b)(vii) of this section.

8
9 (e) All monies received by the department under
10 subsection (d) of this section shall be deposited into an
11 ignition interlock account. Interest earned on monies in
12 the account shall be credited to the account. All monies
13 in the account including earned interest are continuously
14 appropriated to the department and shall be expended only
15 for the purpose of operating the ignition interlock program
16 required by this article.

18 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2012.
