Young entrepreneurs-limiting license requirements.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to counties, cities and towns; prohibiting  
2 counties, cities and towns from requiring a license, permit  
3 or other authorization for a business operated by a minor  
4 as specified; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 15-1-103(a)(xiii) and 18-2-101 by  
9 creating a new subsection (b) are amended to read:

11 **15-1-103. General powers of governing bodies.**

12

13 (a) The governing bodies of all cities and towns may:

14

1           (xiii) License, tax and regulate any business  
2 whatsoever conducted or trafficked in within the limits of  
3 the city or town for the purpose of raising revenue, and  
4 any license taxes imposed shall be uniform in respect to  
5 the class of business upon which imposed. ÷ No license,  
6 permit or other authorization shall be required for a  
7 business that is operated:

9           (A) Only occasionally. For purposes of this  
10 subparagraph, "occasionally" means that the business is not  
11 a habitual or regular activity of the operator; and

13           (B) By an operator who has not attained the  
14 age of eighteen (18) years.
