## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to small claims procedures; removing the
- 2 requirement that an appearance fee be deposited with the
- 3 court; and providing for an effective date.

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5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 1-21-201 and 1-21-202(a) are amended
- 8 to read:

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10 1-21-201. Procedure generally; jurisdiction extended.

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- 12 In the trial of civil cases before any circuit court in
- 13 which the amount claimed, exclusive of costs, does not
- 14 exceed six thousand dollars (\$6,000.00), the procedure and
- 15  $\frac{\text{costs are is}}{\text{costs are is}}$  as defined in W.S. 1-21-201 through 1-21-205.
- 16 The department of revenue may consolidate claims for

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- 1 collection of taxes against a single taxpayer into a single
- 2 case under the procedures in W.S. 1-21-201 through 1-21-205
- 3 subject to specified dollar limitations.

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- 5 1-21-202. Commencement of actions; remedy cumulative;
- 6 continuance to obtain attorney; docketing.

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- 8 (a) Actions may be commenced, heard and determined
- 9 under W.S. 1-21-201 through 1-21-205 if the state, any
- 10 governmental entity, any natural person, corporation,
- 11 partnership, association or other organization appears
- 12 before any circuit court and executes an affidavit reciting
- 13 the full address of the defendant, the nature of the claim,
- 14 the amount due and stating that demand has been made and
- 15 payment refused. The plaintiff shall deposit an appearance
- 16 fee of four dollars (\$4.00) which shall be retained by the
- 17 court as costs and taxed to the party against whom judgment
- 18 <del>is rendered.</del> The remedy provided by this article is
- 19 cumulative and not exclusive.

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21 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2017.
