A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to alcoholic beverages; clarifying
 2 conditions on shipments of wine to households; and
 3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 12-2-204(a), (b) and (d)(i) and
 8 12-4-412(h)(i) are amended to read:

10 **12-2-204. Out-of-state shipment of manufactured wine;**
 11 **license; fees; restrictions; conditions.**

13 (a) Notwithstanding any law, rule or regulation to
 14 the contrary, any person currently licensed in its state of
 15 domicile as an alcoholic liquor or malt beverage
 16 manufacturer, importer, wholesaler or retailer who obtains

1 an out-of-state shipper's license, as provided in this
2 section, may ship no more than a total of thirty-six (36)
3 liters of manufactured wine whether or not listed with the
4 liquor division as part of its inventory and distribution
5 operation directly to any one (1) household in this state
6 in any twelve (12) month period.

7
8 (b) Notwithstanding any law, rule or regulation to
9 the contrary, any person currently licensed in its state of
10 domicile as an alcoholic liquor or malt beverage
11 manufacturer, importer, wholesaler or retailer who obtains
12 an out-of-state shipper's license, as provided in this
13 section, may ship to any Wyoming retail establishment which
14 holds a liquor license in this state ~~or any household in~~
15 ~~this state~~ any manufactured wine which is not listed with
16 the liquor division as part of its inventory and
17 distribution operation.

19 (d) Any out-of-state shippers licensed pursuant to
20 this section shall:

21
22 (i) Not ship more than a total of thirty-six
23 (36) liters of manufactured wine whether or not listed with

1 the liquor division as part of its inventory and
2 distribution operation to any one (1) household in this
3 state during any twelve (12) month period. In the event any
4 out-of-state shipper ships more than ninety (90) liters of
5 any particular manufactured wine to any combination of
6 households or licensed retailers in this state, the
7 out-of-state shipper shall offer to sell the manufactured
8 wine to the liquor division at wholesale prices;

9
10 **12-4-412. Microbrewery and winery permits;**
11 **authorized; conditions; dual permits and licenses;**
12 **satellite winery permits; direct shipment of wine; fees.**

13
14 (h) Any licensed winery holding a winery permit
15 pursuant to this section shall:

16
17 (i) Not ship more than a total of thirty-six
18 (36) liters of its manufactured wine whether or not listed
19 with the liquor division as part of its inventory and
20 distribution operation to any one (1) household in this
21 state during any twelve (12) month period;

1 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2016.
