- 14 not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) if he
- 15 lights a fire in any woods or on any prairie outside of any
- 16 <u>structure</u> and leaves the vicinity of the fire without

extinguishing it or containing it so it does not spread and

is not likely to spread the fire or taking appropriate

action to reasonably ensure that the fire is contained.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2013.
