7	engineer who has not graduated from a doctoral curriculum
8	in engineering approved by the board shall submit evidence
9	satisfactory to the board showing that the applicant:

14	engineer intern certificate and has four (4) years of
15	engineering experience in increasing responsibility and

License on the basis of comity. 2 3 4 (a) An applicant who holds a license issued by another jurisdiction to practice professional engineering 5 or professional land surveying may be issued a professional 6 license provided: 7 8 9 (i) The applicant has not been disciplined by 10 another jurisdiction unless the board determines that a 11 sufficient amount of time has passed since the occurrence 12 of the incident giving rise to the cause of discipline or 13 the discipline is sufficiently minor that the board 14 believes the offense is not relevant to the ability of the applicant to practice; 15 16 17 (b) An applicant who holds a license issued by another jurisdiction with requirements determined by the 18 19 board to be similar to or more stringent than those of 20 Wyoming to practice professional engineering 21 professional land surveying, and who has held the license

for fifteen (15) years immediately prior to submitting the

application, may be issued a professional license provided 1 2 the applicant: 3 4 (i) Has not been disciplined in any jurisdiction 5 unless the board determines that a sufficient amount of 6 time has passed since the occurrence of the incident giving rise to the cause of discipline or the discipline is 7 8 sufficiently minor that the board believes the offense is 9 not relevant to the ability of the applicant to practice; 10 and 11 12 33-29-703. Disciplinary proceedings. 13 14 (b) The board may conduct investigations and issue 15 subpoenas for the attendance of witnesses and the 16 production of evidence books, records, electronic records, 17 documents and other evidence the board deems relevant to an 18 investigation or hearing. 19 20 Section 2. This act shall apply to applications filed 21 with the Wyoming board of professional engineers and professional land surveyors on or after the effective date 22 of this act. 23
