for

1 AN ACT relating to insurance; providing immunity from
2 liability for cooperating with and furnishing information
3 regarding suspected insurance code violations as specified;
4 and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 26-2-131(b) is amended to read:

10 **26-2-131. Immunity from liability.**

12 (b) No cause of action shall arise nor shall any
13 liability be imposed against any person for the act of
14 communicating or delivering information or data to the
15 commissioner, the commissioner's authorized representative

1 or examiner, law enforcement agencies or any governmental
2 agency established to detect and prevent fraud pursuant to
3 an examination made under this chapter or any other
4 investigation, if the act of communication or delivery was
5 performed in good faith and without fraudulent intent.

7 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2012.
