22	This account is intended to provide for financial assurance			
23	coverage required by federal law and shall be used by the

which will require an expenditure of funds in excess of the 1 2 funds available in the corrective action account; or 3 4 (ii) Funds in the account are less than the amount required by federal law to provide for financial 5 6 assurance coverage or adequate leaking underground storage 7 tank remediation. 8 9 (q) The director shall submit a report to the joint 10 minerals, business and economic development interim 11 committee by June 15, 2019 and by June 15 of every year 12 thereafter, describing the amount to be withheld in the 13 corrective action account pursuant to subsection (a) of 14 this section, and the factors used in making that 15 determination. 16 17 (r) In the event the director exercises the 18 authorization provided under subsection (p) of this account, the director shall inform the joint minerals, 19 20 business and economic development interim committee in 21 writing of the withholding of the distribution.
