A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to workforce services; transferring 2 oversight of Serve Wyoming to department of workforce 3 services; amending department of workforce services 4 confidentiality provisions; revising the membership of and 5 transferring oversight of the governor's council for 6 employment and rehabilitation of the handicapped as specified; transferring the displaced worker and education 7 program to the department of workforce services; updating 8 9 the entities to be consulted in preparing the displaced 10 worker and education statewide plan; and providing for an effective date. 11

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13 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 14

Section 1. W.S. 9-1-223(a) and (f)(ii), 9-2-2607(a), 27-1-110, 27-1-111, 27-1-112, 27-13-101(a)(iv) and 27-13-102(a)(intro) are amended to read:

Serve Wyoming; composition; powers and duties; definitions. 3 4 5 (a) Serve Wyoming is transferred from the department of workforce services to the office of the governor to the 6 7 department of workforce services and shall operate as a private not-for-profit corporation, as specified in this 8 9 section. 10 11 (f) As used in this section: 12 13 (ii) "Serve Wyoming" means the not-for-profit 14 corporation within the governor's office department of workforce services to implement the purposes of the 15 16 National and Community Service Act of 1990. 17 18 9-2-2607. Confidentiality of information; disclosure; 19 reimbursement. 20 21 (a) Except as otherwise provided, information 22 maintained pursuant to this article shall not be disclosed 23 in a manner which reveals the identity of the employing unit or the individual. Duties of council and department. 6 7 The department of employment workforce services, with advice of the council, shall carry on a continuing program 8 9 employment of physically, mentally, to promote the 10 emotionally and otherwise handicapped persons by creating 11 statewide interest in the rehabilitation and employment of 12 by obtaining the handicapped and and maintaining 13 cooperation from all public and private groups and 14 individuals in the field. The council shall work in cooperation with the president's committee on employment of 15 16 the handicapped in order to more effectively carry out the 17 purposes of this act.

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22 The department of <u>employment workforce services</u>, on behalf 23 of the council, is authorized to receive any gifts, grants 24 or donations made for any of the purposes of its program.

1 2 27-13-101. Definitions. 3 4 (a) As used in this act: 5 6 (iv) "Division" means the department of 7 employment workforce services; 8 27-13-102. Powers and duties; rules and regulations. 9 10 (a) The division shall, in conjunction with the 11 12 department of education, the department of economic planning and development business council, the office of 13 the commissioner of labor department of employment, the 14 employment security commission workforce development 15 council, the University of Wyoming and the community 16 17 college commission, establish and maintain a plan to implement the occupational transfer and retraining programs 18 19 and services for displaced workers created under this act. 20 The plan shall designate: 21 Section 2. 22 23

(a) It is the intention and direction of the
legislature that:

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4 (i) All duties of the governor's office with 5 respect to the Serve Wyoming, governor's council for 6 employment and rehabilitation of the handicapped and the 7 displaced worker and education programs be transferred to 8 the department of workforce services;

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10 (ii) All unexpended funds not otherwise 11 obligated and any other property, if any, of the governor's 12 exclusively dedicated to office the Serve Wyoming, 13 governor's council for employment and rehabilitation of the 14 handicapped and the displaced worker and education programs be transferred to the department of workforce services; 15

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17 (iii) Any contract, agreement or obligation entered into or assumed by the governor's office with 18 19 the Serve Wyoming, governor's council for respect to 20 employment and rehabilitation of the handicapped and the 21 displaced worker and education programs, if the execution 22 or assumption was within the lawful powers of the department 23 governor's office, be assumed by the of 24 workforce services;

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2	(iv) Any policy adopted by the governor's office
3	with respect to the Serve Wyoming, governor's council for
4	employment and rehabilitation of the handicapped and the
5	displaced worker and education programs remain in effect
6	unaltered as policy of the department of workforce services
7	until amended or repealed by the department of workforce
8	services.
