- 17 for a subdivision permit, provided the board may by rule

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7 (vi) A study evaluating the water supply system

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for 1 (IV) Plans the **mitigation** 2 resolution of water right conflicts resulting which will 3 result from the use of water within the proposed 4 subdivision, as identified by the study, unless such 5 conflicts are subsequently deemed not to exist by a more thorough engineering analysis to the satisfaction of the 6 7 board; 8 9 (C) Where individual on-lot wells are proposed as the water supply system, a report submitted by 10 11 the subdivider of study results demonstrating the safety and adequacy of the water supply system shall address, at a 12 13 minimum, the following: 14 15 List of all (IV) surface and groundwater rights which will be used or which may will be 16 17 affected, including state engineer application and permit numbers, and description of expected effects identified by 18 the study; and 19 20 21 (V) Plans for the mitigation 22 resolution of water right conflicts resulting which will 23 result from the use of water within the proposed 24 subdivision, as identified by the study, unless such

conflicts are subsequently deemed not to exist by a more thorough engineering analysis to the satisfaction of the board.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2011.
