A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to daylight saving time; exempting the
2 state from the daylight saving time change; providing for
3 the observance of standard time; and providing for an
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 8-4-110 is created to read:

9

10 **8-4-110. Exemption from daylight saving time change.**

12 Pursuant to the authority granted by 15 U.S.C. 260a(a), the
13 state is exempt from the provisions of 15 U.S.C. 260a(a)
14 that require the standard time be advanced by one (1) hour
15 during a stated period of each year. The state, including

1 all its political subdivisions, shall be subject to this
2 section and shall not advance the standard time pursuant to
3 15 U.S.C. 260a(a).

5 **Section 2.** This act is effective January 1, 2017.
