7 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-1-104(a)(xii) and 7-13-1301(a)(vi)
8 are amended to read:

10 **6-1-104. Definitions.**

12 (a) As used in this act, unless otherwise defined:

14 (xii) "Violent felony" means murder,
15 manslaughter, kidnapping, sexual assault in the first or
16 second degree, robbery, aggravated assault and battery,

1 aircraft hijacking, arson in the first or second degree, ~~or~~
2 aggravated burglary or a violation of W.S. 6-2-314(a)(i),
3 ~~or~~ 6-2-315(a)(ii), 6-3-111, 6-5-204(c) or 6-2-508(b);

7 (a) As used in W.S. 7-13-1301 through 7-13-1304:

9 (vi) "Violent felony" means murder,
10 manslaughter, kidnapping, sexual assault in the first or
11 second degree, robbery, aggravated assault and battery,
12 aircraft hijacking, arson in the first or second degree, ~~or~~
13 aggravated burglary or a violation of W.S. 6-3-111,
14 6-5-204(c) or 6-2-508(b);

16 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2011.
